When the library's home page appears, click on **Databases**, then click on the **INFOTRAC** link.

At this time you may be asked for a 'password.' It is the number on the back of your library card.

Enter this number; Click .

When INFOTRAC's home page appears,



select [General Reference Center Gold](#) 1980 – Sept 2008

- Search by **Keyword** or by **Subject** (includes subdivisions for a topic) or
 - Click [More search options](#) to retrieve full text articles, to combine terms, or to search specific date ranges.

Advanced search example:

Keyword "**middle ages**" retrieves articles with this exact phrase.

Keyword **cook*** retrieves **cooks cooking, cookery**, etc.

Page down, select "**Full Text**" to view entire article.
